Classroom Teacher Job Description

The Talmud Torah of Minneapolis is the supplemental Jewish school for grades 2-8 co-led by Adath Jeshurun Congregation and Beth El Synagogue. We engage students of all backgrounds in educational experiences that provide a foundation and the lifelong tools to live an intentionally Jewish life. We offer a rigorous education that builds knowledge of Judaism and its traditional practices based on the teachings and egalitarian, pluralistic principles of the Conservative movement.

We are seeking creative and enthusiastic teachers for our elementary and middle school programs. Elementary school classes (grades 2-5) meet twice a week, either on Sunday mornings and Wednesday afternoons or on Tuesday and Thursday afternoons. Middle school classes (grades 6-8) meet on weekday afternoons and evenings, and schedules vary by grade.
